

Roxane Malo Leadership Scholarship

“A stalwart of the North Shore real estate scene, Roxane Mauro Malo influenced one of the foremost property markets in the country.” Says the Chicago Tribune, November 13, 2003.



Roxane Malo was a leader in real estate sales as well as in the Association. Past Chairman of the Board for the North Shore – Barrington Association of REALTORS[®], Roxane also served as Director of the Illinois Association of REALTORS[®] and was about to serve on the National Association of REALTORS[®] Board of Directors before her untimely death. Roxane has chaired almost all of the North Shore – Barrington Association of REALTORS[®] committees, was chairman of the IAR Convention Committee, and a Director for the Multiple Listing Service of Northern Illinois.

The Roxane Malo Leadership Scholarship Fund has been established as a tribute to Roxane’s personal commitment to REALTOR[®] leadership. Each year the Fund will award one or more scholarships to selected individual(s) for the continuation and expansion of their leadership skills in a real estate related field.

The Roxane Malo Leadership Scholarship is awarded to select individuals wishing to further their education at a junior college, college, or university level. Scholarships are awarded with the stipulation that funds are used solely for study or training relating to leadership in a real estate related field. Scholarship grants may also be awarded for leadership training in a real estate related field provided by the Illinois Association of REALTORS[®], the National Association of REALTORS[®], a local Chamber of Commerce, the American Society of Association Executives, or similar organizations. The number of scholarships awarded each year will be determined by the Foundation, with awards not exceeding \$500.

The Foundation

The Illinois Real Estate Educational Foundation is a not-for-profit organization established to aid and promote real estate education throughout Illinois. The Foundation is supported through voluntary contributions from organizations and individuals who recognize the importance of furthering academic experience and training in the Illinois Real Estate industry.

Scholarship Eligibility

Any Illinois resident who has held a valid real estate license for a minimum of one year, working in Illinois, and is interested in furthering their real estate career through leadership training is eligible to apply for a scholarship.

This Scholarship cannot be used for reimbursement of previously attended courses. Individuals may only receive the Roxane Malo Leadership Scholarship once.

SELECTION CRITERIA

All application materials must be completed and returned to the Foundation's office not later than October 1. Application materials should be mailed to the **Real Estate Educational Foundation**, P.O. Box 2607, Springfield, IL 62708.

The Foundation determines scholarship recipients based on the following criteria:

- The applicant's indication of interest in pursuing a career in leadership training in real estate;
- The applicant's course of study centers on leadership development, along with a desire to become involved as a leader in the REALTOR® Association or related trade organization;
- The receipt and review of at least three letters of recommendation (references need to come from at least one real estate broker from the office with which the applicant is affiliated and two letters from officers from the local association of which the applicant is a member, one of which may be the local Association Executive Officer);
- The applicant has not previously been awarded a Roxane Malo Leadership Scholarship.

All of the following must be submitted by October 1, along with the Roxane Malo Scholarship application form: (The following checklist is for your convenience only)

- _____ 1. The applicant's typed, signed statement of activities within their local association. This should include mention of any committee memberships or chairmanships, attendance at local association meetings and functions, attendance at meetings and functions of the Illinois Association of REALTORS® or the National Association of REALTORS®.
- _____ 2. Information regarding community involvement, including details of local, state and national participation in civic and service clubs, charitable activities, political action, fraternal or religious groups.
- _____ 3. A letter of recommendation from at least one real estate broker from the office with which the applicant is affiliated. (*Replies from the references are to be sent directly to the Foundation, are confidential, and are under no circumstances to be revealed to the candidate*).
- _____ 4. Letters of recommendations from two officers (one which may be the local Association Executive Officer) from the local Association of which the applicant is a member. (*Replies from these references are to be sent directly to the Foundation, are confidential, and are under no circumstances to be revealed to the candidate*). Information may include committees on which you have served, attendance at the local Association, State Association and National Association functions.
- _____ 5. A personal letter providing information about why this particular scholarship is needed, plans for use of the scholarship, and the applicant's future goals as they relate to the use of this scholarship.

NOTE: Some requested material will not apply to an applicant who is not a member of a local Association and the Illinois Association of REALTORS®.
